COVENANT

NUMBERS 21:4-9

The story of Genesis 3 introduces the reality of sin and that with sin comes death.

The giving of the Ten Commandments (the Law) reveals that humans on their own are not able to live a sinless life. With sin comes death, but in God we find forgiveness, healing, and redemption from sin.

The creation of the serpent on the pole reminds the people that sin leads to death, and they can choose to look upon the snake on the pole and live or choose not to and receive the punishment for their sins. To confront the serpent sculpture is to confront one's own sin and its result. It is the spiritual equivalent of looking in a mirror

As a nation of people, they are at a low point in their history, and God will use their time in the wilderness to shape Israel to be a light to the world; however, the lessons are not always easy to learn.

The Season of Lent

Lent is the 40-day (plus Sundays) period between Ash Wednesday and Resurrection Sunday. The purpose of the Christian Season of Lent is the preparation of the Christian for Resurrection Sunday through prayer, fasting, repentance of sins, almsgiving, and self-denial.
